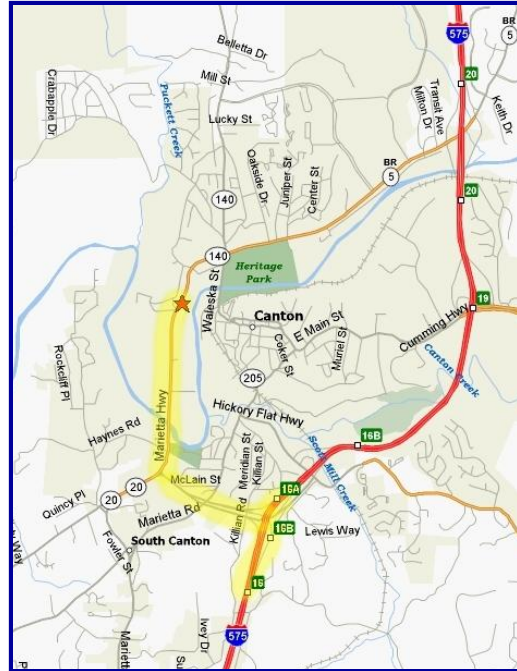


Directions to the Rock Barn

NORTH on Marietta Highway 1 Mile to the Rock Barn

The Rock Barn is on the LEFT. Approx. 100 Yds before the Rock Barn turn LEFT on Westview Ln. Westview Ln wraps behind the building and provides access to parking on the grass next to the facility.
